Multiparametric Prostate MRI (mpMRI) has taken a prominent role in the diagnostic pathway of prostate cancer management in recent years.

This is due to advances in scanner technology, image sequences and quality.

Imaging is utilised at the pre biopsy, pre and post treatment stages of prostate cancer management.

In this talk, Dr Gan will focus on the latest evidence for the use of mpMRI in the initial diagnosis of suspected prostate cancer. This is often prompted by suspicious findings on digital rectal examination and elevated PSA level. He will also share an overview of the mpMRI classification system that you may encounter in radiology reports and touch on the use of imaging in prostate biopsy.
