GASTROclear is a blood test that uses microRNA tumour markers to assess stomach cancer risk. If the test score shows high risk of stomach cancer, further evaluation using gastroscopy will be highly recommended. GASTROClear helps patients avoid an endoscopy if they are found to be at low risk after undergoing the blood test. The blood test is more cost-effective and less invasive than a gastroscopy or biopsy.

It is highly recommended for the following groups-

- 1) Above 40 years of age
- 2) Gastric pain, bloatedness
- 3) History of Helicobacter pylori infection,
- 4) Overweight
- 5) High intake of salted, smoked, preserved food
- 6) Smoking and alcohol consumption
- 7) Family history of stomach cancer
